**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING MULTISTATE HEALTH CARE CENTERS
IN CONNECTICUT AND ELIMINATING A HEALTH CARRIER
UTILIZATION REVIEW REPORT FILING REQUIREMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2016*) The Insurance
4 Department shall submit to the joint standing committee of the
5 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance
6 all guidelines and bulletins the department intends to issue. Such
7 guidelines and bulletins shall be issued not earlier than sixty days after
8 such submission. Such sixty-day period shall not apply if an
9 emergency event occurs that poses a risk to life, limb or property in
10 this state and the Insurance Commissioner determines that such
11 occurrence necessitates the issuance of a guideline or bulletin prior to
12 the expiration of such sixty-day period."
