**"AN ACT CONCERNING AMERICAN LEGION STATE FUND  
COMMISSION TRANSPARENCY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 46b-25 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 [No] (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no  
6 license may be issued by the registrar until both persons have  
7 appeared before the registrar and made application for a license. The  
8 registrar shall issue a license to any two persons eligible to marry  
9 under this chapter. The license shall be completed in its entirety, dated,  
10 signed and sworn to by each applicant and shall state each applicant's  
11 name, age, race, birthplace, residence, whether single, widowed or

12 divorced and whether under the supervision or control of a  
 13 conservator or guardian. The Social Security numbers of both persons  
 14 shall be recorded in the "administrative purposes" section of the  
 15 license. If the license is signed and sworn to by the applicants on  
 16 different dates, the later date shall be deemed the date of application.

17 (b) The registrar shall issue a license to a member of the armed  
 18 forces, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103, who is on active  
 19 duty and absent from this state and the person with whom such  
 20 member makes application for such license, provided (1) such person  
 21 appears before the registrar and provides a statement (A) sworn to by  
 22 such member of the armed forces before an individual described in  
 23 subdivision (14) of section 1-24, and (B) signed under penalty of false  
 24 statement by both such member of the armed forces and such  
 25 individual, (2) the statement indicates that such member of the armed  
 26 forces (A) is on active duty and absent from this state, and (B) intends  
 27 to make application for a license with such person, and (3) the  
 28 application for a license otherwise complies with the requirements of  
 29 subsection (a) of this section."
