"AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MEDICAID-FUNDED STATE PROGRAMS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Secretary of the Office of
4 Policy and Management shall establish a plan to ensure the
5 coordinated and efficient delivery of health and human services. The
6 plan shall include, but need not be limited to: (1) Performance-based

7 contract incentives for private, nonprofit providers to improve the
 8 delivery of services, (2) the use of population data to help determine
 9 performance measures, (3) assisting such providers to obtain and
 10 utilize computer software for billing and record keeping that is
 11 compatible with state technology, (4) shared data collection among
 12 state health and human services agencies to the extent permissible
 13 under state and federal laws governing the privacy of records, (5) the
 14 potential use of federal accreditation standards for providers by state
 15 agencies with overlapping oversight over providers, (6) simplified and
 16 streamlined licensure and reporting processes for private, nonprofit
 17 providers, and (7) the review and adoption of best practices for
 18 delivery of health and human services.

19 (b) Not later than March 1, 2017, the Secretary of the Office of Policy
 20 and Management shall submit a report on the plan to the joint
 21 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
 22 matters relating to aging, appropriations and the budgets of state
 23 agencies, children, education, human services, the judiciary, public
 24 health, and program review and investigations in accordance with the
 25 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes."
