**"AN ACT MAKING CHANGES TO THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ALLOW RETENTION OF THE PLAN D COPARTICIPANT OPTION AFTER DIVORCE AND TO CEASE CREDITING INTEREST ON CERTAIN INACTIVE, NONVESTED MEMBERS, AND ELIMINATING CERTAIN OBSOLETE LANGUAGE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 7-438 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2016*):

5 (a) Any member retired under this part who again accepts  
6 employment from this state or from any municipality of this state other  
7 than a participating municipality, shall continue to receive his or her  
8 retirement allowance while so employed, and shall be eligible to  
9 participate, and shall be entitled to credit, in the state retirement  
10 system for the period of such state employment, but any such member

11 shall not be eligible to participate or be entitled to credit in any  
12 municipal retirement system for the period of such municipal  
13 employment.

14 (b) If a member is retired under this part and again accepts  
15 employment from the same municipality from which he or she was  
16 retired or any other participating municipality, he or she shall be  
17 eligible to participate, and shall be entitled to credit, in the municipal  
18 employees' retirement system for the period of such municipal  
19 employment. Such member shall receive no retirement allowance  
20 while so employed except if (1) such employment is for less than  
21 twenty hours per week, [or] (2) his or her services are rendered for not  
22 more than ninety working days in any one calendar year, provided  
23 that any member reemployed for a period of more than ninety  
24 working days in one calendar year shall reimburse the Municipal  
25 Employees' Retirement Fund for retirement income payments received  
26 during such ninety working days, or (3) such member does not  
27 participate in the municipal employees' retirement system during the  
28 period of his or her reemployment."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
