***"AN ACT CONCERNING TOXIC FLAME RETARDANT CHEMICALS
IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS AND UPHOLSTERED RESIDENTIAL
FURNITURE."***

1 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 1 in its entirety and
2 substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(1) "Children's product" means a product, or article used as a
4 component of a product, designed or intended primarily for use by or
5 for children twelve years of age or younger, including, but not limited
6 to, clothing, toys, nursing pillows, crib mattresses, changing pads and
7 strollers. "Children's product" does not include food, beverages,
8 dietary supplements, pharmaceutical products, biologics, consumer
9 electronics, batteries, slings and catapults, sets of darts with metallic
10 points, toy steam engines, bicycles, tricycles, video toys that can be
11 connected to a video screen and are operated at a voltage exceeding
12 twenty-four volts, chemistry sets, BB guns, pellet guns, air rifles, roller
13 skates, scooters, model rockets, athletic shoes with cleats or spikes,

14 pocket knives and multitools, consumer and children's electronic
15 products, including, but not limited to, personal computers, audio and
16 video equipment, calculators, wireless telephones, video game
17 consoles and hand-held devices that incorporate a video screen and are
18 used to access interactive software and associated peripherals,
19 interactive software intended for leisure and entertainment, including,
20 but not limited to, computer games and associated storage media such
21 as compact discs, snow sporting equipment, including, but not limited
22 to, skis, poles, boots, snowboards, sleds and bindings, sporting
23 equipment, including, but not limited to, bats, balls, gloves, sticks,
24 pucks and pads, off-highway motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles,
25 children's toys that are subject to the most recent version of the ASTM
26 F963, Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Toy Safety, devices
27 as defined by the federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 21 USC 321(h)
28 or products governed by federal motor vehicle standards contained in
29 49 CFR 571.213 and 49 CFR 571.302;"
