**"AN ACT STUDYING THE FEASIBILITY OF THE STATE PROVIDING WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS TO CERTAIN PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANTS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2016*) The Commissioner of  
4 Administrative Services shall, within available appropriations, conduct  
5 a study of the feasibility of the state providing workers' compensation  
6 coverage for personal care attendants who provide home care to  
7 consumers in state-funded programs. Such study shall include, but not  
8 be limited to, consideration of (1) the benefits to the state, personal care  
9 attendants and consumers, and (2) the cost to the state of providing  
10 such coverage, and shall further consider the means by which such  
11 coverage would be provided. Not later than December 31, 2016, the  
12 commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions  
13 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees

14 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor  
15 and public employees and appropriations and the budgets of state  
16 agencies. Such report shall include the results of such study and any  
17 recommendations for administrative or legislative action necessary to  
18 provide such workers' compensation coverage."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
