**"AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL IMPLEMENTATION OF
CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORMS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2016*) Any contractor bidding
4 on a contract for the construction, reconstruction, alteration,
5 remodeling, repair or demolition of any public building or any other
6 public work by the state administered by the Department of
7 Transportation or an awarding authority, as defined in section 4b-91 of
8 the general statutes, shall submit a written certification with such bid.
9 Such written certification shall state, under penalty of false statement,
10 that such contractor and any principal or key personnel of such
11 contractor (1) have not been convicted, entered a plea of guilty or nolo
12 contendere under state or federal law for embezzlement, theft, forgery,
13 bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen
14 property or any other offenses (A) indicating a lack of business
15 integrity or business honesty, or (B) involving corrupt practices or

16 breach of the public trust, and (2) are not subject to any legal or
 17 administrative proceedings pending or concluded adversely against
 18 the contractor, principal or key personnel (A) indicating a lack of
 19 business integrity or business honesty, or (B) involving corrupt
 20 practices or breach of the public trust. Such certification shall also
 21 indicate whether any predecessor, affiliate or prior principal or key
 22 personnel of such contractor has been convicted, pled guilty or nolo
 23 contendere to an offense listed in subdivision (1) of this section or been
 24 subject to any legal or administrative proceedings as described in
 25 subdivision (2) of this section. The Department of Transportation or an
 26 awarding authority shall not award any such contract to a contractor
 27 that fails to submit the certification required under this section."
