**"AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Secretary of the  
4 Office of Policy and Management, in consultation with the Long-Term

5 Care Planning Committee, established pursuant to section 17b-337 of  
 6 the general statutes, and the Long-Term Care Advisory Council,  
 7 established pursuant to section 17b-338 of the general statutes, shall  
 8 prepare and implement a comprehensive plan to ensure that seventy-  
 9 five per cent of persons receiving Medicaid long-term care benefits in  
 10 Connecticut shall receive such benefits in home and community-based  
 11 services by July 1, 2025.

12 (b) The Department of Social Services, in consultation with the  
 13 Office of Policy and Management, shall annually include in its long-  
 14 term care strategic rebalancing plan (1) progress toward meeting the  
 15 July 1, 2025, deadline, and (2) enumeration of obstacles to meeting the  
 16 deadline. The department shall submit the report to the joint standing  
 17 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
 18 relating to aging, appropriations and the budgets of state agencies,  
 19 human services and program review and investigations."
