14 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2016*) Notwithstanding section 9-701 of the
15 general statutes, the sum of \$1,447,896 shall be transferred from the
16 Citizens' Election Fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund
17 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, for the purpose of increasing
18 equalization aid grants during said fiscal year for the following towns:
19 Ansonia, Bristol, Manchester, Meriden, Milford and Windham, to the
20 levels of such grants for such towns for the fiscal year ending June 30,
21 2016. Grants paid out of the Citizens' Election Fund for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2017, shall be reduced proportionally by the amount of
23 \$1,447,896."
