- 1 Strike section 120 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 120. (*Effective July 1, 2016*) The amount appropriated in section
4 1 of public act 15-244, as amended by section 155 of public act 15-5 of
5 the June special session and section 1 of senate bill 501 of the current
6 session, to the Judicial Department, for Youth Services Prevention, for
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, shall be transferred to the
8 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services and made
9 available in said fiscal year for grants to substance abuse treatment
10 providers for long-term stay treatment beds."

11 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
12 internal references accordingly:

13 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (30) of section 21a-240 of the 2016 supplement
14 to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in
15 lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2016*):

16 (30) "Narcotic substance" means any of the following, whether
17 produced directly or indirectly by extraction from [substances] a
18 substance of vegetable origin, or independently by means of chemical
19 synthesis, or by a combination of extraction and chemical synthesis:
20 (A) Morphine-type: (i) Opium [and] or opiate, [and] or any salt,
21 compound, derivative, or preparation of opium or opiate which [are] is
22 similar [thereto] to any such substance in chemical structure or which
23 [are] is similar [thereto] to any such substance in physiological effect
24 and which [show] shows a like potential for abuse, which [are] is a
25 controlled [substances] substance under this chapter unless modified;
26 (ii) any salt, compound, isomer, derivative, or preparation [thereof] of
27 any such substance which is chemically equivalent or identical [with]
28 to any [of the substances] substance referred to in clause (i) of this
29 subparagraph, but not including the isoquinoline alkaloids of opium;
30 (iii) opium poppy [and] or poppy straw; or (iv) (I) fentanyl or any salt,
31 compound, derivative or preparation of fentanyl which is similar to
32 any such substance in chemical structure or which is similar to any
33 such substance in physiological effect and which shows a like potential
34 for abuse, which is a controlled substance under this chapter unless
35 modified, or (II) any salt, compound, isomer, derivative or preparation
36 of any such substance which is chemically equivalent or identical to
37 any substance referred to in subclause (I) of this clause; or (B) cocaine-
38 type; [, coca] Coca leaves [and] or any salt, compound, derivative or
39 preparation of coca leaves, [and] or any salt, compound, isomer,
40 [derivatives] derivative or preparation [thereof] of any such substance
41 which is chemically equivalent or identical [with] to any [of these
42 substances] such substance or which [are] is similar [thereto] to any
43 such substance in physiological effect and which [show] shows a like
44 potential for abuse, but not including decocainized coca leaves or

45 extractions of coca leaves which do not contain cocaine or ecgonine;"

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
