"AN ACT CONCERNING A SECOND CHANCE SOCIETY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 54-76l of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2016*):

6 (d) The records of any such youth, or any part thereof, shall be
7 available to the victim of the crime committed by such youth, an
8 attorney of the victim or the Victim Advocate to the same extent as the
9 [record of the case of a defendant in a criminal proceeding in the
10 regular criminal docket of the Superior Court is available to a victim of
11 the crime committed by such defendant] records are available to the
12 defendant pursuant to subsection (b) of this section. The court shall

13 designate an official from whom such victim, attorney of the victim or
14 the Victim Advocate may request such information. Information
15 disclosed pursuant to this subsection shall not be further disclosed."
