Reductions in regulatory burdens for low-emitting sources***

Dear Senator Chapin and Representative Becker:

Pursuant to section 4-170 of the Connecticut General Statutes, I am submitting a revised proposal for your consideration and approval. At the Legislative Regulation Review Committee meeting on December 15, 2015, the original proposal was rejected without prejudice. One substantive concern and six technical corrections were cited to justify the rejection. We have addressed the substantive concern and the technical corrections by making the recommended revisions. Enclosed you will find the revised proposal, the certification page with the Attorney General's approval of the resubmitted proposal, the fiscal impact statement, small business impact statement, the original notice of intent and the hearing report. Also attached to this letter is a copy of the Legislative Commissioner's Office report and a chart that identifies how the substantive concern and the technical corrections were addressed in the revised proposal.

This proposal was developed to streamline certain regulatory requirements for low emitting sources and to ease compliance burdens on certain small sources. We look forward to an approval of this revised proposal so that the benefits of the proposal may be available to the regulated community.
