Dam Safety Regulations

Dear Co-Chairs Chapin and Becker and Ranking Members Doyle and O'Neill:

Pursuant to Section 4-170 of the Connecticut General Statutes, I resubmit for the Legislative Regulation Review Committee's consideration and approval proposed regulation revisions concerning dam safety classification, registration, and inspection and adoption of two new sections concerning completion and submission of emergency action plans for high-hazard dams.

The Committee rejected the initial submission without prejudice on December 15, 2015 and adopted the recommendations of the Legislative Commissioners' Office (LCO) that were outlined in a memorandum to the Committee dated December 15, 2015. The version of the regulations attached addresses the substantive and technical concerns listed in the LCO memorandum. For ease of reference I have attached a summary of revisions as required by § 4-170 that explains the changes made to address the substantive concerns and confirms that all technical corrections were made. Prior to submission to the Committee, the revised regulations were submitted to the Office of the Attorney General for approval as to legal sufficiency. As indicated in the signed certification, the Attorney General approved the revised regulations as to legal sufficiency on December 31, 2015.
