Proposed Regulation

2015-028A Department of Social Services **“THE STATE-ADMINISTERED GENERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM”** The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended 17b-198-1 through 17b-198-19. (CLJ Notice Date: 8/18/2015, A.G. Approval Date: 1/4/2016 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 2/9/2016).

The above captioned regulation was **LRRC - Approved with Technical Corrections** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 1/26/2016. The necessary corrections are outlined in the attached report from the Legislative Commissioners’ Office. Senator Kelly proposed an amendment which was adopted to add the following to the technical corrections in the LCO report. The first technical correction is on page 3, in section 17b-198-3(c); “at or by mail to” should be “at, or by mail to,” for clarity. The second technical correction is on page 39, in section 17b-198-13(a)(2); “When the department receives all information necessary” should be “Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this subsection, when the department receives all information necessary” for clarity.

After the necessary changes have been made, each agency must file a certified electronic copy of the regulation accompanied by a certification statement from the agency head with the Office of the Secretary of the State within fourteen days of its approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. If for any reason the agency fails to file the regulation in the prescribed time, it must notify the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the reasons for such failure within five days of the missed filing deadline.
