### Proposed Regulation

2016-005A

Department of Motor Vehicles “**ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES FOR “PER SE” SUSPENSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR’S LICENSE**” The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended Sections 14-227b-1 to 14-227b-3; 14-227b-5 to 14-227b-6; 14-227b-10 to 14-227b-16; 14-227b-18 to 14-227b-19; 14-227b-21; 14-227b-24; 14-227b-27; 14-227b-29a and repealed Section 14-227b-26. (CLJ Notice Date: 1/25/2016, A.G. Approval Date: 7/25/2016 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 9/6/2016).

The above captioned regulation was **LRRC - Approved with Technical Corrections** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 8/23/2016. The necessary corrections are outlined in the attached report from the Legislative Commissioners’ Office.

After the necessary changes have been made, each agency must file a certified electronic copy of the regulation accompanied by a certification statement from the agency head with the Office of the Secretary of the State within fourteen days of its approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. If for any reason the agency fails to file the regulation in the prescribed time, it must notify the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the reasons for such failure within five days of the missed filing deadline.
