Board of Pardons and Paroles **“REPEAL OF ADMINISTRATIVE PARDONS PROCESS”** The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is repealed Sections 54-124a(j)(2)-1 through 54-124a(j)(2)-8, inclusive. (CLJ Notice Date: 2/17/2016, A.G. Approval Date: 4/5/2016 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 6/9/2016).

The above captioned regulation was **LRRC - Approved in Whole** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 5/24/2016.

Each agency must file a certified electronic copy of the regulation accompanied by a certification statement from the agency head with the Office of the Secretary of the State within fourteen days of its approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. If for any reason the agency fails to file the regulation in the prescribed time, it must notify the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the reasons for such failure within five days of the missed filing deadline.
