Notice of Intent

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168(a) of the *Connecticut General Statutes* (CGS) the **Board of Pardons and Paroles** hereby gives notice that it proposes to adopt a regulation concerning the **repeal of the Administrative Pardons process**.

Specified comment period (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(A))

A comment period of not less than thirty days shall begin upon posting of this notice to the eRegulations System website and shall end on **March 21, 2016**.

Detailed description of the proposed regulation (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(B))

This is a repeal of the current Administrative Pardons process.

Statement of the purposes for which the regulation is proposed (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(C))

This repeal of the current Administrative Pardons process is in preparation for its replacement for a process consistent with Public Act 15-2.
