Notice of Intent

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168(a) of the *Connecticut General Statutes* (CGS) the **Office of Policy & Management** hereby gives notice that it proposes to adopt a regulation concerning **Personal Data**.

Specified comment period (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(A))

A comment period of not less than thirty days shall begin upon posting of this notice to the eRegulations System website and shall end on **March 23, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.**

Detailed description of the proposed regulation (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(B))

The proposed regulation updates OPM's Personal Data regulations required by section 4-196 of the Connecticut General Statutes. The amendments are technical in nature to update the agency mailing address, division names, and to include the data collected through the Connecticut Partnership for Long-Term Care program.

Statement of the purposes for which the regulation is proposed (CGS section 4-168(a)(1)(C))

Outdated information has been updated in this regulation. In addition, data collected through the Connecticut Partnership for Long-Term Care (Partnership) program, administered by the Office of Policy and Management, has been included. Under the authority of CGS 38a-475, the Partnership program collects from participating insurance companies personal data of purchasers of long-term care insurance policies approved through the Partnership program. Partnership purchaser data is maintained for the purposes of managing and evaluating the Partnership program, documenting the extent of Medicaid Asset Protection earned under the Partnership program and assisting Partnership policyholders with questions regarding their policies. Partnership policyholder data must be kept strictly confidential and is not shared with anyone except the actual policyholder or legal representative.
