NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND AND REPEAL A REGULATION

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to section 14-36a of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend section 14-36a-2 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and to repeal section 14-36a-1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Statement of Purpose: This regulation amends the enumerated listing of state issued restrictions on an operator's license to comply with new federal requirements for the operation of commercial motor vehicles. The regulation also creates a newly designated restriction ("3") for the operation of three-wheeled motorcycles in accordance with Public Act 2015-46. In addition, the revision incorporates the establishment of a "Y" restriction to designate Connecticut's "drive only" license which became effective on January 1, 2015.

Lastly, section 14-36a-1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is unnecessary due to the legislative revision in 2013 to subsection (d) of section 14-36a of the Connecticut General Statutes. The remaining language in section 14-36a-1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies has become obsolete.
