Dear Senator Chapin and Representative Becker:

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) of § 4-170 of the Connecticut General Statutes, this is to advise the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the approval by the Attorney General of the regulation entitled "Amendment Making Technical Changes to Department of Motor Vehicles Regulations."

Enclosed please find the agency's regulatory proposal for your review and approval. The amendments contain updates that conform to our current statutes and agency requirements. The changes include: (1) technical revisions to insurance requirements for motorcycles at time of registration; (2) elimination of an outdated identification document for the issuance of an operator's license; (3) updates to the requirements for the restraint of children in an ambulance; and (4) a 2014 legislative change to signage requirements for student transportation vehicles. It also updates statutory and regulatory citations throughout the proposal to conform to proper drafting protocol set forth by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. All of the proposed amendments are technical in nature with no impact to the public.
