Hi Kirstin,

This is to notify you that, pursuant to Committee Rule 12(a), DSS would like to withdraw proposed regulation 2016-020 from tomorrow's Committee agenda. We are doing this to accommodate a preference by Committee membership that we attend a meeting with members of the Elder Bar and interested Committee members. We agree to participate in such a meeting and intend to resubmit the proposed regulation for the November Committee meeting. This assumes that, prior to 10/4/16, the deadline for submitting a proposed regulation for the November agenda, we will be able hold the meeting, incorporate any necessary changes based on the meeting and the LCO report, and obtain certification from the Attorney General's Office that the updated proposed regulation is legally sufficient. If it proves impossible to meet this deadline, then our intention will be to resubmit the proposed regulation in time for the December Committee meeting.
