Notice of Intent to Adopt Regulations

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, notice is hereby given that the Department of Labor proposes to modify the Department's unemployment compensation regulations pertaining to employer responses, under the authority of CGS § 31-250.

Statement of Purpose: The proposed regulations are designed to align the regulations with Public Act 12-125; to provide the employer with good cause for nonparticipation; and to modify the employer participation regulations to align with SIDES technological requirements.
