

**Subject: Support for House Bill 5461, "An Act Concerning the Certificate of Title for Older Model Motor Vehicles."**

Dear State Senator/Representative:

The Connecticut Council of Car Clubs (4C's) is an association of approximately 35 Connecticut Car Clubs that monitors legislation in the state. We represent on the order of 2000 antique auto hobbyists in Connecticut. The 4C's Board of Directors is comprised of volunteer auto hobbyists.

The 4C's supports House Bill 5461 that specifies that while a certificate of title shall not be required for any motor vehicle older than 20 model years old, the commissioner shall issue a certificate of title for such motor vehicle at the request of the owner, provided that the owner pays a fee to cover the administrative costs of issuing the title. While not required, many antique auto hobbyists would like to obtain titles for their antique motor vehicles.

The 4C's understands the Department of Motor Vehicles currently has an administrative process in place to obtain a title for any motor vehicle older than 20 model years. The 4C's would be happy to work with the Department of Motor Vehicles to facilitate this process as appropriate.

The 4C's respectfully requests that the Transportation Committee support House Bill 5461.
