**HB 772      "An Act Requiring Emergency Generators in Certain Housing for the Elderly"**

HB 772 would require any public housing project consisting of not less than one hundred units for elderly persons to install and maintain at least one emergency power generator capable of providing a minimum of four to twelve hours of electrical power. While the proposed bill is well intentioned, CCM requests that the Committee oppose this unfunded mandate as the fiscal implications on a municipality can be onerous.
