MCAC POSITION: OPPOSE

The Mechanical Contractors Association of Connecticut is opposed to SB128 for the following reasons:

- **This proposed bill indicates that the current state regulations which business and industry must comply with are too onerous.**
- **Every effort should be made by the Commerce Committee, in cooperation with other committees of cognizance for agencies that have promulgated these regulations to correct or eliminate these onerous regulations as soon as possible.**
- **In fairness to all businesses in the state, who have remained in business despite the regulatory burden, should also be exempt from these regulations.**

Years ago, many committees continued to work in the mid-term to attack these types of problems and would return in the short session with fully drafted bills that had been thoroughly studied in the interim.

A first step would be to identify the regulations that should be corrected or eliminated.
