

Dear Sir or Madam,

I would like to enter the following comments into the records for SB 630 and SB 106.

Please support SB 630, to strengthen and extend Connecticut's Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS), which requires utilities to get a gradually-increasing percentage of energy from renewable sources, beyond 2020. I also feel that biomass from whole-tree harvesting is not a truly renewable form of fuel. Wind, solar and tidal power should be the sources of energy that these companies should be required to use.

Please oppose SB 106, which would undercut our rapidly growing solar and wind industries by potentially allowing nuclear power to co-opt their incentives. The sentiment about biomass applies here also.
