Dear Senator McLaughlin, Chair, General Law Committee,

I began calling my Senator and Representative this morning to urge that Ct. be counted among the states in favor of our election for President and Vice-President be decided by the National Popular Vote.

Under the system currently in place Connecticut is all but neglected in the political process leading up to the election, while voters of states with a large number of votes through the electoral college are courted. This is but one of the reasons that argues in favor of our endorsing the National Popular Vote initiative; another is that reasons for maintaining the electoral college system are outdated.
