AN ACT REQUIRING BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO CONDUCT PERIODIC TESTING OF SCHOOL WATER SUPPLIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 169 of the general statutes be amended to require local
- 2 and regional boards of education and regional educational service
- 3 centers to submit water samples to the Department of Public Health
- 4 for the purpose of conducting periodic testing of lead contamination in
- 5 school potable water sources and systems in school buildings.

Statement of Purpose:

To require school districts to monitor and maintain safe drinking water in school buildings.
