**AN ACT ADOPTING THE INTERSTATE COMPACT TO ELECT THE
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES BY NATIONAL POPULAR
VOTE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to enter Connecticut
- 2 into the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by
- 3 National Popular Vote, thereby committing the state's votes in the
- 4 Electoral College to the presidential candidate that wins the popular
- 5 vote nationally regardless of whether such presidential candidate wins
- 6 the popular vote within Connecticut.

Statement of Purpose:

To adopt the interstate compact to elect the President of the United
States by national popular vote and join other states that have already
adopted the compact.
