AN ACT ELIMINATING THE FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF PURPLE HEART NUMBER PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 14-20b of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2017*):
- (a) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, at the request of any veteran or member of the armed forces, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103, or the surviving spouse of such veteran or member, shall register any motor vehicle owned or leased for a period of at least
- 7 one year by such person and shall issue a special certificate of
- 8 registration and a set of number plates for each such <u>motor</u> vehicle.
- 9 The plates shall expire and be renewed as provided in section 14-22.
- 10 The commissioner shall charge a fee for such plates, which fee shall
- 11 cover the entire cost of making [the same and which] such plates and
- shall be in addition to the fee for registration of such motor vehicle,
- 13 except the commissioner shall not charge a fee for such plates that
- 14 recognize the Military Order of the Purple Heart.
- 15 (b) Any such member of the armed forces who is dishonorably

- 16 discharged shall return such plates to the commissioner not later than
- 17 thirty days after such discharge. The commissioner shall not renew
- 18 such plates for any motor vehicle owned or leased by any such
- 19 member of the armed forces who is dishonorably discharged.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
