AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTERING OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each all-terrain
- 2 vehicle to be registered through the state, except if such all-terrain
- 3 vehicle is operated solely on the property of the operator, and that the
- 4 registration fee for the all-terrain vehicle be thirty dollars annually.
- 5 Further, the revenue from such registrations would be used by the
- 6 Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to maintain trails
- 7 for all-terrain vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the registration of certain all-terrain vehicles to generate proceeds for the maintenance of all-terrain vehicle trails.
