AN ACT CONCERNING SOBER LIVING HOMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require persons or entities
- 2 renting property promoted as a sober living home to (1) register as a
- 3 business with the municipality in which such property is located, (2)
- 4 register with the state Department of Public Health, (3) have naloxone
- 5 available on the premises if any person renting such property has a
- 6 history of opioid addiction, and (4) provide training in the
- 7 administration of naloxone to all tenants of each home if any tenant
- 8 living there has a history of opioid addiction.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide safeguards for the health and well-being of residents of sober living homes and notice to municipalities and the state of the existence of such properties to ensure proper oversight.
