***AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF RANKED-CHOICE VOTING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Secretary of the State conduct a study on the merits of and
- 2 best practices in implementing for elections a method of casting and
- 3 tabulating votes in which voters rank candidates in order of
- 4 preference, tabulation proceeds in sequential rounds in which last-
- 5 place candidates are defeated and the candidate with the most votes in
- 6 the final round is elected.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To conduct a study of ranked-choice voting.
