**AN ACT ELIMINATING DUPLICATIVE AND BURDENSOME  
LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN NONPROFIT  
COMMUNITY SERVICE PROVIDERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 4 of the general statutes be amended so that nonprofit
- 2 providers of services at community facilities required to be licensed by
- 3 the state be deemed to be licensed if the requirements of the relevant
- 4 national accrediting organization are more stringent than those of the
- 5 state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reduce costs for nonprofit providers by providing a means for them  
to forgo duplicative and burdensome state licensing requirements if  
they can demonstrate accreditation from an accepted national  
accrediting body that has requirements more stringent than the state's.
