**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRESENTATION OF A PERMIT TO  
CARRY A PISTOL OR REVOLVER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 29-35 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2017*):

4 (b) The holder of a permit issued pursuant to section 29-28 shall  
5 carry such permit upon one's person while carrying such pistol or  
6 revolver. Such holder shall present his or her permit upon the request  
7 of a law enforcement officer, [who has reasonable suspicion of a crime  
8 for purposes of verification of the validity of the permit or  
9 identification of the holder,] provided such holder is carrying a pistol  
10 or revolver that is observed by such law enforcement officer.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require individuals who openly carrying a pistol or revolver to produce their permit upon request of a law enforcement officer if the firearm is visible to such officer.
