**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT
MAY BE USED TO TRACK THE LOCATION AND MOVEMENT OF A
PERSON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit the use of an
- 2 electronic device that is utilized to track the location and movement of
- 3 another person unless such other person has consented to be tracked
- 4 by the device, and (2) provide that if a person has consented to be
- 5 tracked by an electronic device, the term of such consent may not
- 6 exceed five years.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the privacy of state residents.
