AN ACT CONCERNING DEFINED CONTRIBUTION RETIREMENT PLANS FOR NEWLY HIRED STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require all state employees
- 2 and officials hired on and after the effective date of this act to
- 3 participate in defined contribution retirement plans rather than the
- 4 current defined benefit system.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a defined contribution pension plan for new state employees.
