***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CREDIT AGAINST THE HOSPITAL TAX FOR HOSPITALS THAT MAKE BEDS AVAILABLE FOR OPIOID ADDICTION TREATMENT SERVICES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a pilot program be established to allow a credit against the tax
- 2 imposed on hospitals under chapter 211a of the general statutes for
- 3 hospitals that make beds available for the provision of services to
- 4 individuals suffering from opioid addiction.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To provide an incentive to hospitals to make beds available for the provision of services to individuals suffering from opioid addiction.
