AN ACT CONCERNING AN EMPLOYEE'S DUTY TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF A CLAIM FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION TO HIS OR HER EMPLOYER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 31-294c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that an employee send a written copy of the notice of claim for
- 3 workers' compensation to the human resources department of the
- 4 business in which he or she is employed at the principal place of such
- 5 business in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To streamline the filing of workers' compensation claims by expanding the reach of public act 16-112 to include all employers.
