**AN ACT REQUIRING A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FOR PERSONS WHO ENROLL IN A CLASS FOR CERTIFICATION AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to require every
- 2 person who enrolls in a class for certification as emergency medical
- 3 services personnel to submit a valid criminal history records check
- 4 performed under section 29-17a of the general statutes or, in lieu
- 5 thereof, a valid and current permit to carry a pistol or revolver.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require a criminal history records check for persons who enroll in a class for certification as emergency medical services personnel.
