**AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE COMPLAINT
RESOLUTION PROCESS WITHIN THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN
RIGHTS AND OPPORTUNITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 814c of the general statutes be amended to require the
2 Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities to: (1) Address data
3 limitations that impede the tracking and processing of complaints filed
4 with the commission, (2) improve reporting to the General Assembly
5 and the Governor on the performance of all divisions within the
6 commission, (3) implement a complaint tracking system that ensures
7 all statutory time frames for the processing of complaints are met, (4)
8 implement uniform complaint processing procedures, (5) implement
9 measures that separate housing discrimination complaints from all
10 other complaints filed with the commission, and (6) add an
11 independent mediator for the resolution of complaints.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for a more efficient and effective complaint resolution process within the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.
