**AN ACT REQUIRING AN ULTRASOUND PROCEDURE PRIOR TO THE
TERMINATION OF A PREGNANCY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a health care
- 2 provider to administer an ultrasound procedure for the health benefit
- 3 of the patient prior to engaging in any procedure that will terminate
- 4 such patient's pregnancy.

To ensure the health and well-being of an individual who decides to
terminate a pregnancy.
