AN ACT REMOVING PENSIONS FROM THE SCOPE OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to remove pensions from the
- 2 scope of collective bargaining agreements for state employees hired on
- 3 or after July 1, 2012, and to require all state employees hired on or after
- 4 July 1, 2012, to participate in a defined contribution benefit plan rather
- 5 than the current defined benefit system.

Statement of Purpose:

To save the state money and reduce the state's long-term liabilities by enacting comprehensive pension reform.
