AN ACT CONCERNING EXCEPTIONS TO THE PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENT IN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (h) of section 31-53 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) increase the prevailing wage threshold to one million
- 3 dollars for the total cost of work to be performed in connection with
- 4 new construction of any public works project and to four hundred
- 5 thousand dollars for the total cost of work to be performed in
- 6 connection with remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation,
- 7 alteration or repair of any public works project, and (2) index such
- 8 thresholds to inflation annually.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide relief from municipal mandates by increasing the prevailing wage thresholds.
