**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MONITORING OF HEALTH CARE TRENDS BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to increase the authority of the
- 2 Attorney General to monitor health care market trends by collecting
- 3 information from any health care provider, health care provider
- 4 organization or private or public health care payer through document
- 5 production, interrogatories and testimony under oath regarding health
- 6 care cost, cost trends and factors that contribute to cost growth in the
- 7 state's health care system and the relationship between provider costs
- 8 and payer premium rates.
