***AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS FROM
ADVERTISING REGARDING HEALTH CARE RELATED TO
PREGNANCY AND CONTRACEPTION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit organizations that
- 2 are not established medical organization or organizations without
- 3 licensed medical professionals to advertise regarding health care
- 4 related to pregnancy and contraception.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that individuals seeking time-sensitive health care related to pregnancy and contraception do not face delays caused by false advertising from organizations that are not established medical organizations or organizations without licensed medical personnel.
