**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CHARGING OF UNEMPLOYMENT  
COMPENSATION BENEFITS TO EMPLOYERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that when an
- 2 employee voluntarily terminates his or her employment with an
- 3 employer, and the employee is subsequently terminated by a second
- 4 employer under circumstances that permit the payment of
- 5 unemployment compensation benefits, the payment of unemployment
- 6 compensation benefits after the termination shall not be charged to the
- 7 account of the first employer.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit charging the payment of unemployment compensation benefits to an employer when an employee voluntarily terminated his or her employment, and the employee is subsequently terminated by a second employer and paid unemployment compensation benefits.
