**"AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 9-605 of the general statutes is amended by adding  
4 subsection (f) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (NEW) (f) Notwithstanding any provision of subsections (a) to (e),  
6 inclusive, of this section, a state senator or state representative shall not  
7 serve as chairperson, treasurer, deputy treasurer or other officer of, or  
8 otherwise establish or control, any political committee except (1) a  
9 legislative caucus committee, or (2) a legislative leadership committee.

10 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any  
11 provision of chapters 155 to 157, inclusive, of the general statutes, a

12 candidate or committee required under section 9-603 of the general  
13 statutes to file any statement or certification with the town clerk of a  
14 municipality, pursuant to said chapters, shall not make any  
15 contribution to a legislative caucus committee, legislative leadership  
16 committee or state central committee."
