**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 10-19o of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
5 *1, 2017*):

6 (a) The Commissioner of Education shall establish a program to  
7 provide grants to youth service bureaus in accordance with this  
8 section. Only youth service bureaus which (1) were eligible to receive  
9 grants pursuant to this section for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007,  
10 [or which] (2) applied for a grant by June 30, 2012, with prior approval  
11 of the town's contribution pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, [or  
12 which] (3) applied for a grant during the fiscal year ending June 30,  
13 2015, or (4) applied for a grant during the fiscal year ending June 30,  
14 2017, with prior approval of the town's contribution pursuant to

15 subsection (b) of this section, shall be eligible for a grant pursuant to  
 16 this section. [for any fiscal year commencing on or after July 1, 2012.]  
 17 Each such youth service bureau shall receive a grant of fourteen  
 18 thousand dollars. The Department of Education may expend an  
 19 amount not to exceed two per cent of the amount appropriated for  
 20 purposes of this section for administrative expenses. If there are any  
 21 remaining funds, each such youth service bureau that was awarded a  
 22 grant in excess of fifteen thousand dollars in the fiscal year ending  
 23 June 30, 1995, shall receive a percentage of such funds. The percentage  
 24 shall be determined as follows: For each such grant in excess of fifteen  
 25 thousand dollars, the difference between the amount of the grant  
 26 awarded to the youth service bureau for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
 27 1995, and fifteen thousand dollars shall be divided by the difference  
 28 between the total amount of the grants awarded to all youth service  
 29 bureaus that were awarded grants in excess of fifteen thousand dollars  
 30 for said fiscal year and the product of fifteen thousand dollars and the  
 31 number of such grants for said fiscal year."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
