"AN ACT AUTHORIZING BEAR HUNTING IN CONNECTICUT."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2017*) Notwithstanding any
4 provision of the general statutes, no person shall hunt any black bear if
5 such bear is (1) smarter than the average bear, (2) fed from a picnic
6 basket, (3) merely nibbling or noshing, (4) featured in or associated
7 with any film production of The Walt Disney Company, or (5) fed
8 from a honey pot provided such pot is of sufficient size, as determined
9 by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection, such
10 that the tongue, snout and head of such bear has sufficient space to
11 extend, lick, sniff and explore, as applicable, without becoming stuck
12 in such pot."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
